

Identificaion of sub-species of *Mus musculus* L. 1766 (Muridae, Rodentia) of Khorasan Provice by Multivariant Analysis

ABSTRACT

Mus musculus has been multivariantly analysed, using 16 morphometrics and 10 morphological attributes. The studied popilation samples belonged to Birdjand, Gonabad, Torbat-jam and Mashad cities.

M. m. musculus was the sub-species occurring in the centre and north of Khorasan and *M. m. bactrianus* in the southern parts of the Province.
