

## SOME BIO - ECOLOGICAL FEATURES OF COTTON JASSID<sup>1</sup> IN FARS PROVINCE<sup>2</sup>

### SUMMARY

According to five consecutive years researches, the Cotton Jassid has seven generations in southern part of Fars Province. The winter is passed as mated adult females, being able to lay their eggs whenever the climatic conditions are favourable for their activities.

The main peak of population takes place almost always once in a year, occurring sooner in the precocious cotton fields than that in late ones (for more details refer to the figures in Farsi text prepared in both Farsi and English languages).
