TRANSMISSION OF CITRUS GREEN SPOT (1)

SUMMARY

Field experiments in the Caspian Sea area demonstrated that citrus green spot (probably the same as Impietratura) could be transmitted by chip budding but not by contaminated horticultural tools. The incubation period was found to be one year.
