

## **IDENTIFICATION AND DISTRIBUTION OF BANDED WINGS GRASSHOPPERS (ORTH. OEDIPODINAE) OF KARADJ**

### **Abstract**

Among species of grasshoppers of family *Acrididae* collected from Karaj vicinities, 26 species was of subfamily *Oedipodinae*, belonging to 15 following genera:

*Acrotalus, Aiolopus, Brunerella, Heliopteryx, Hilethera, Leptopternis, Locusta, Mioscirtus, Oedaleus, Oedipoda, Pseudoceles, Pyrgocera, Scintharista, Sphingonotus, Sphingoderus.*

Identification key of the species is arranged and the distributional areas for each species is located.
