

IDENTIFICATION AND DISTRIBUTION OF BANDED WINGS GRASSHOPPERS (*ORTH. OEDIPODINAE*) OF KARADJ

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Abstract

Among species of grasshoppers of family *Acrididae* collected from Karaj vicinities, 26 species was of subfamily *Oedipodinae*, belonging to 15 following genera:

Acrotylus, *Aiolopus*, *Brunerella*, *Heliapteryx*, *Hilethera*, *Leptopternis*, *Locusta*, *Mioscirtus*, *Oeda-leus*, *Oedipoda*, *Pseudocoles*, *Pyrgodera*, *Scintharista*, *Sphingonotus*, *Sphingoderus*.

Identification key of the species is arranged and the distributional areas for each species is located.

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
